

Portsmouth Conservation Commission



 - preserve natural esthetic areas within the town.







- located in Portsmouth, RI, in the heart of Aquidneck Island.




























Bristol Ferry Town Commons Committee

- **♦** This is the site of a town common dating back to 1714. A ferry service for farmers started here in 1640.
- → This 1.5 acre space was originally used by farmers and others to keep their livestock and other goods while waiting for the ferry to Bristol.
- ★ THIS BECAME A TRANSPORTATION HUB FOR PORTSMOUTH WITH STEAMBOATS, TROLLEYS, TRAINS AND FERRIES ALL STOPPING HERE.
- ★ THE OPENING OF THE MOUNT HOPE BRIDGE IN 1929 ENDED THE FERRY SERVICE.
- **♦** MT. HOPE PARK HAS BEAUTIFUL SUNSET VIEWS OF THE BRIDGE.
